

**NOTICE OF A SPECIAL MEETING THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN
OF THE CITY OF POPLARVILLE, MISSISSIPPI
FOR THE TRANSACTION OF IMPORTANT BUSINESS
September 30, 2021, AT 6:00 P.M.**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, pursuant to Mississippi Code Section 21-3-21, the undersigned Mayor has called a special meeting of the Mayor and Board of Aldermen, by way of a Board Order on September 21, 2021, to be held on Thursday, September 30, 2021, at 6:00 p.m., to be held in the Board Room at the Poplarville City Hall, 200 Highway 26 East, Poplarville, Mississippi 39470, for the purpose of discussing the following:

- **ARTISAN PYROTECHNICS, INC. REQUESTS WAIVER OF ORDINANCE FORBIDDING THE IGNITING OF FIREWORKS WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS** - Artisan Pyrotechnics, Inc. has been hired by the Pearl River Community College to provide a player introduction and homecoming fireworks display during homecoming festivities on October 7, 2021, and has requested that, for this event, that the City waive the Ordinance forbidding the igniting of fireworks within the City limits.
- **HALLOWEEN CURFEW** – Reconsider Halloween curfew for door-to-door trick-or-treating.
- **HANCOCK WHITNEY BANK FUNDS TRANSFER SERVICES AGREEMENT** – Request authorization of Hancock Whitney Bank Funds Transfer Services Agreement, which will allow for the wiring of funds from the City’s Main Account and from the Accounts Payable Clearing Account to vendors, as needed.
- **PROMOTE DARIUS THREATS TO OPERATOR – STREETS** - Request authorization to promote Darius Threats from Laborer – Streets to Operator – Streets, effective October 9, 2021, at a pay rate increase from \$12.00 per hour to \$13.92 per hour.
- **AUTHORIZE JOB POSTING FOR LABORER - STREETS**- Request authorization to post the job announcement for Laborer – Streets externally, at a rate of pay not to exceed \$12.00 per hour.
- **RESOLUTION TO DECLARE EMERGENCY WATERLINE REPLACEMENT PURCHASE** – Adopt a Resolution to declare the relocation and replacement of a main waterline buried in Juniper Creek, at/near 1644 Dupont – Harts Chapel Road, as an Emergency Purchase according to MS Code § 21-35-19, at a cost of \$17,400.00 to be paid to ABC Utility Company, Inc.
- **CLAIMS DOCKET:** Approval of the Year-End Claims Docket for FY ending September 30, 2021.
- **TOUCH-A-TRUCK EVENT** – Ms. Mary Alexander, representing the Poplarville First United Methodist Church, has requested authorization to conduct the Touch-A-Truck event at the railroad park, scheduled on October 9, 2021, to be held during the Chamber of Commerce’s Pumpkin Patch event at City Square Park, and has requested to have City-owned Police and Fire Department vehicles and personnel made available for the event. (The event was originally approved on August 3, 2021, to be held at the railroad park, but was associated with the Sweet Tea Festival, which has been cancelled.)
